International Wildlife Crimestoppers Announces Acceptance of Grant Applications for “Wall of Shame” Trailer Upgrades

Blairsville, Georgia, December 1, 2019 – International Wildlife Crimestoppers, announced this week that the organization is accepting applications for “Wall of Shame” trailer equipment/upgrades.

Wall of Shame trailers are traveling exhibits to educate the public about wildlife poaching and its negative effects. The exhibits create a broader awareness to the unending problem of poaching wildlife.

“The effectiveness of trailer exhibits across the country has proven extremely productive in educating the public young and old alike on the very real problem of poaching” said IWC President Lee Ellis. “IWC is glad to be able to offer this type of grant to maintain existing Wall of Shame trailers and enhance efforts to stop poaching”.

The grant application acceptance period will begin December 1, 2019 through January 27, 2020.
