



The International Association of Natural Resources Crimestoppers has received a \$25,000 grant from the Cabela's Outdoor Fund. The Cabela's Outdoor Fund is a tax-exempt organization dedicated to the promotion of conservation and of hunting, fishing, camping, boating, and other outdoor sporting and recreational activities.
