



IWC Grant Request For Anti-poaching Education Trailer Equipment and Upgrades

The International Wildlife Crimestoppers ***Billy Shoemaker Memorial Grant Program*** provides current active IWC members with funding for Anti-poaching Education trailer equipment and upgrades up to \$2,500.

Billy Shoemaker was a friend and committed supporter to International Wildlife Crimestoppers from the time he met our organization until his passing. Billy was not a rich man, but committed a \$100 donation to IWC every month to help stop wildlife crimes and help in the fight to conserve our natural resources which he loved so much.

For consideration, a current association member must be an active member for a period of two consecutive years before applying for a grant. For this purpose, “active” means participates in association’s actions and efforts to promote IWC’s mission, goals, and initiatives.

Read the grant agreement requirements below to understand the requirements of fulfilling the grant before completing this request.

If awarded the anti-poaching education trailer equipment and upgrades grant, I will:

- Utilize the entire grant award for the acquisition of equipment upgrades for an Anti-poaching Education Trailer. (Deadline: 180 days after receipt of check from IWC).
- Submit to IWC a news release outlining my agency’s receipt of the grant award. If applicable, same release will be placed on my agency’s social media outlets. (Deadline: 30 days after receipt of check from IWC).
- Ensure two (2) 12”x16” IWC brand and any other contributing organization logos are displayed on the trailer. (IWC will supply). Also, IWC’s mission statement shall be prominently displayed inside the trailer. Logo placements and usage must be submitted for approval.
- Provide IWC an image of the completed upgrade project. (Deadline: 180 days after receipt of check from IWC).
- Immediately notify the IWC of any situations that may prohibit the use of the grant award for its intended purpose.

After reviewing the requirements, if you able to meet and agree with them, please complete the section below to submit your grant request.
