- Ensure two (2) 12"x16" IWC brand decals and two (2) Pro Bass Shops and Cabela's Outdoor Fund brand decals of the same size are displayed on the trailer. (IWC will supply). Also, IWC's mission statement shall be prominently displayed inside the trailer.
- Ensure two (2) Cabela's Outdoor Fund images are displayed on the trailer. (IWC will supply digital image.)
- Provide IWC an image of the completed upgrade project. (Deadline: 180 days after receipt of check from IWC).
- Immediately notify the tom.mckenney@maine.gov of any situations that may prohibit the use of the grant award for its intended purpose.
- IMPORTANT:** Track the success of the grant for a period of one year by reporting how many times and in which area of my state/province the trailer exhibit was utilized. The **quarterly** report will include the total number (estimate) of visitors to the exhibit each time it is used and the demographics of those visiting the exhibit.
